## Chilli Plant & Chilli Pepper Competition

### Chilli Plant Competitions:

#### **CLASS 1 – BULGARIAN CARROT chilli plant**

Plants to be grown in maximum 2 litre pots. Only one plant per pot, seed grown this year. Plants will be judged on their health, appearance and yield.

#### **CLASS 2 - OPEN COMPETITION any variety of chilli plant**

This competition is open to any chilli variety. The plant must have been sown this year. One plant per pot, any size pot. Plants will be judged on their health, shape and yield.

Just bring the plant(s) with you on **Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> August** and register them at the competition tent in the beech avenue. You may enter one plant only per class. Please be careful to avoid bringing any unwelcome pests on your plant.

### Chilli Pepper Competitions:

These classes are for the fruit only and are open to commercial growers too.

Just like your village horticultural show, this year you can enter your chillies into classes for the fruit only. These will actually be capsicum classes, so if you grow sweet peppers you can enter these too.

**Class 3:** Heaviest pepper including sweet peppers

**Class 4:** Longest cayenne

**Class 5:** Best superhot chilli

**Class 6:** Most interesting oddity/malformation

We will provide a paper plate for each entry to be displayed on. Take your entries to the competition tent in the beech avenue for registration. You may enter some or all classes once only.

### Judging:

Entries must be in by 2.00pm. Judging is at 3.30pm

Judging is done by respected commercial chilli growers, Michael or Joy Michaud of Sea Spring Seeds (they developed the Dorset Naga chilli) and Matt Simpson of Simpson's Seeds. Rosettes will be awarded to the top 3 in each category.
