Online Chilli Plant Competition 2020

Enter before 12 noon on Saturday 1st August 2020

Online Chilli Plant Competition:

CLASS 1 – CALICO variety (Capsicum Annuum) chilli plant

Plants to be grown in maximum 3 litre pots. Only one plant per pot, seed grown this year.

CLASS 2 - OPEN COMPETITION any variety of chilli plant

This competition is open to any chilli variety. The plant must have been sown this year. One plant per pot, any size pot.

To enter:

1. Wait for the announcement on Facebook that the competition is open. This will be made on Thursday early morning.
2. Take a 10 second video clip of your plant, starting at the pot and rising to the tip of the plant, to show the structure, health, looks and yield.
3. Reply to the official announcement post by uploading your video with a comment to say what Class you are entering and what the variety is.
4. You have until 12 noon on Saturday 1st August to upload your video.

Rules:

1. You may enter one plant only per class.
2. Pot-grown plants only. No hydroponics please.
2. Please make sure that your plant was grown in the appropriate size pot (see above).
3. The Judges' decision is final

Judging:

The Competition is open for entries from Thursday 00.01am until 12 noon on Saturday 1st August 2020. Judging is by respected chilli growers, Michael and Joy Michaud of Sea Spring Seeds and Matt Simpson of Simpson's Seeds.

Prizes:

Class 1 and Class 2 winners will receive a £50 Stewarts Garden Centre voucher. 2nd and 3rd places will receive 5 packs of chilli seeds of your choice from Simpsons Seeds and Sea Spring Seeds.
